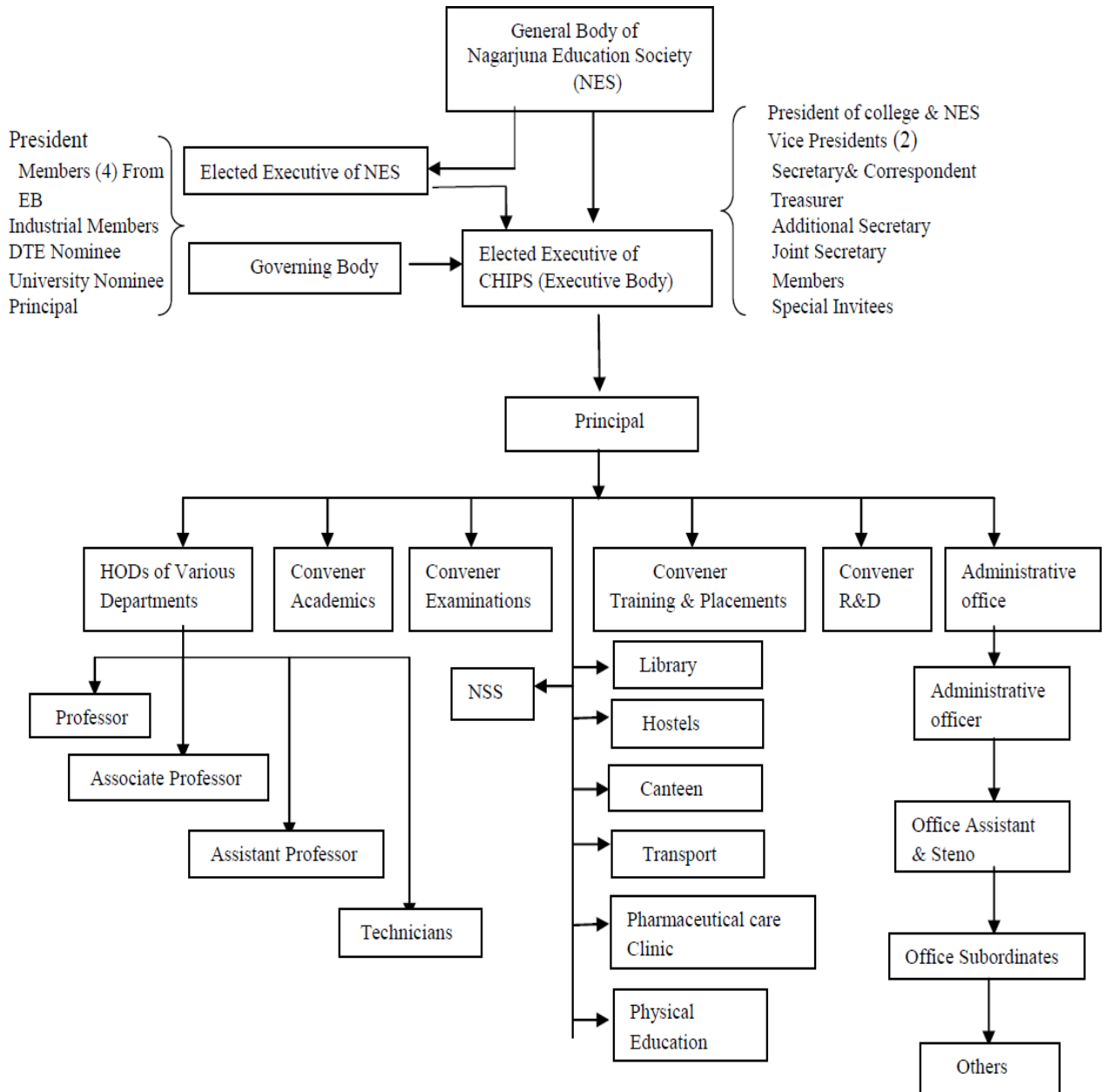

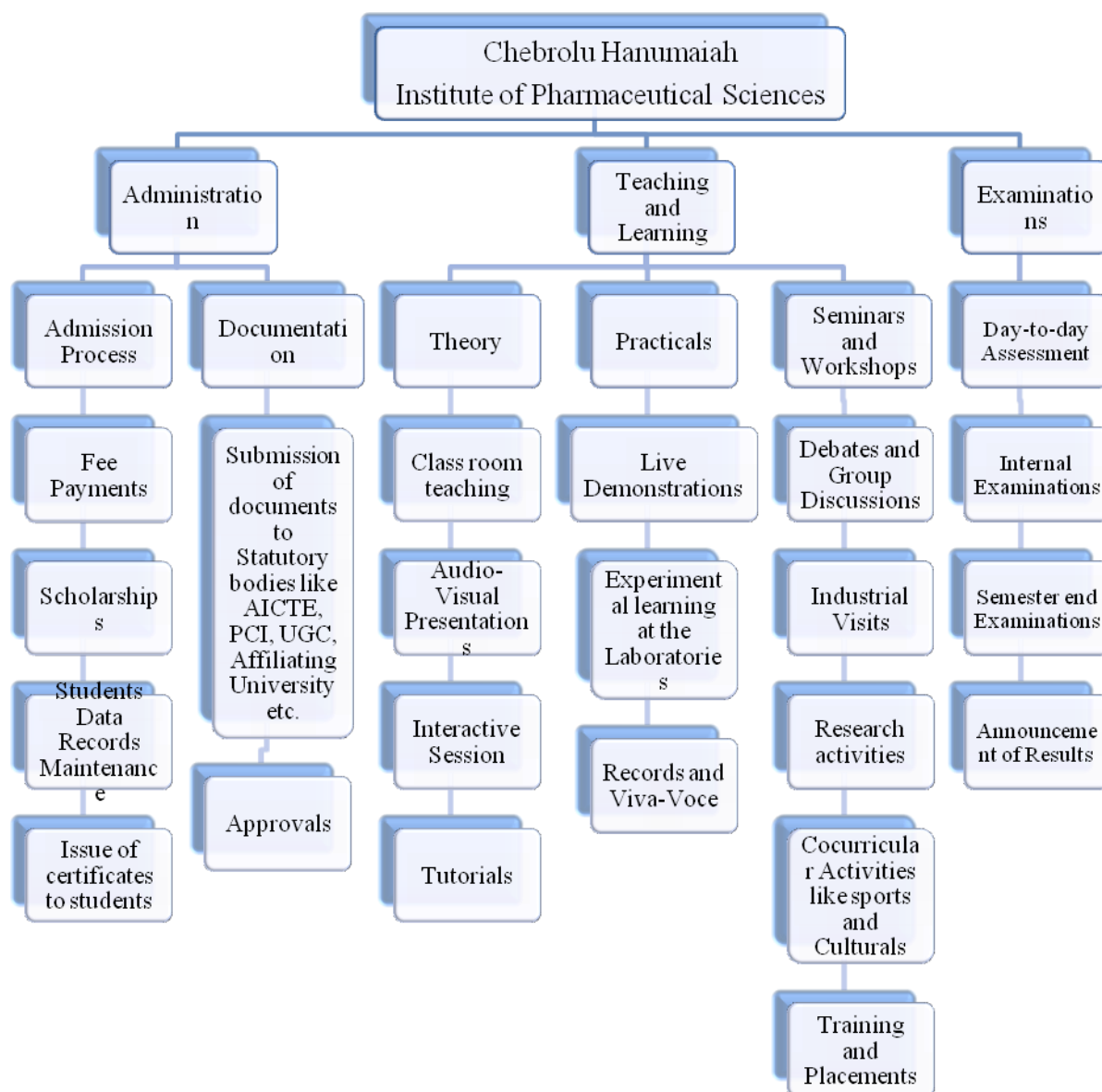
Frequency of Board Meeting and Academic Advisory Body:
